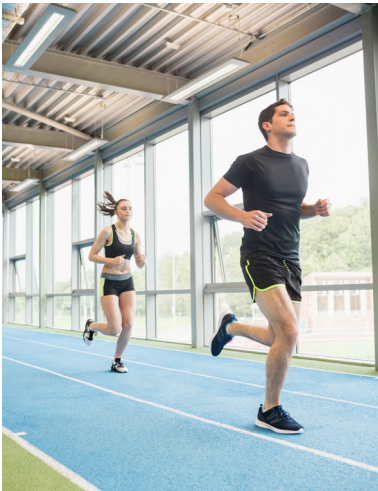

Facility Vision

Market research recommends a 33,000 square foot facility to be constructed and connected to the recently built Graham Medical Group Clinic. This is aided by a permanent endowment fund to help offset annual operating and deferred maintenance costs.

Cost estimates have been vetted based upon regional projects of similar size and scope. This includes anticipated costs for land preparation, furniture, fixtures and equipment, general fees, and contingencies.

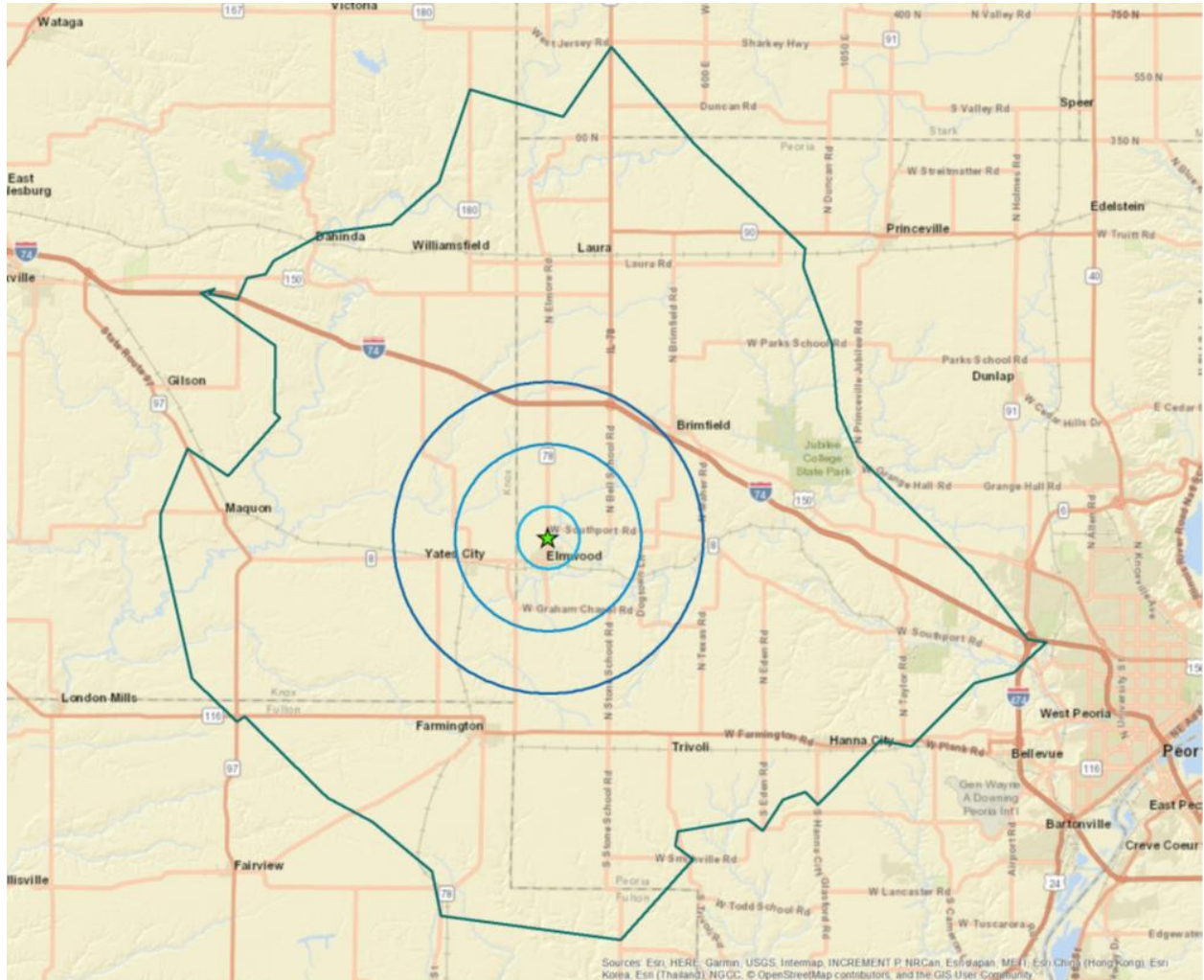

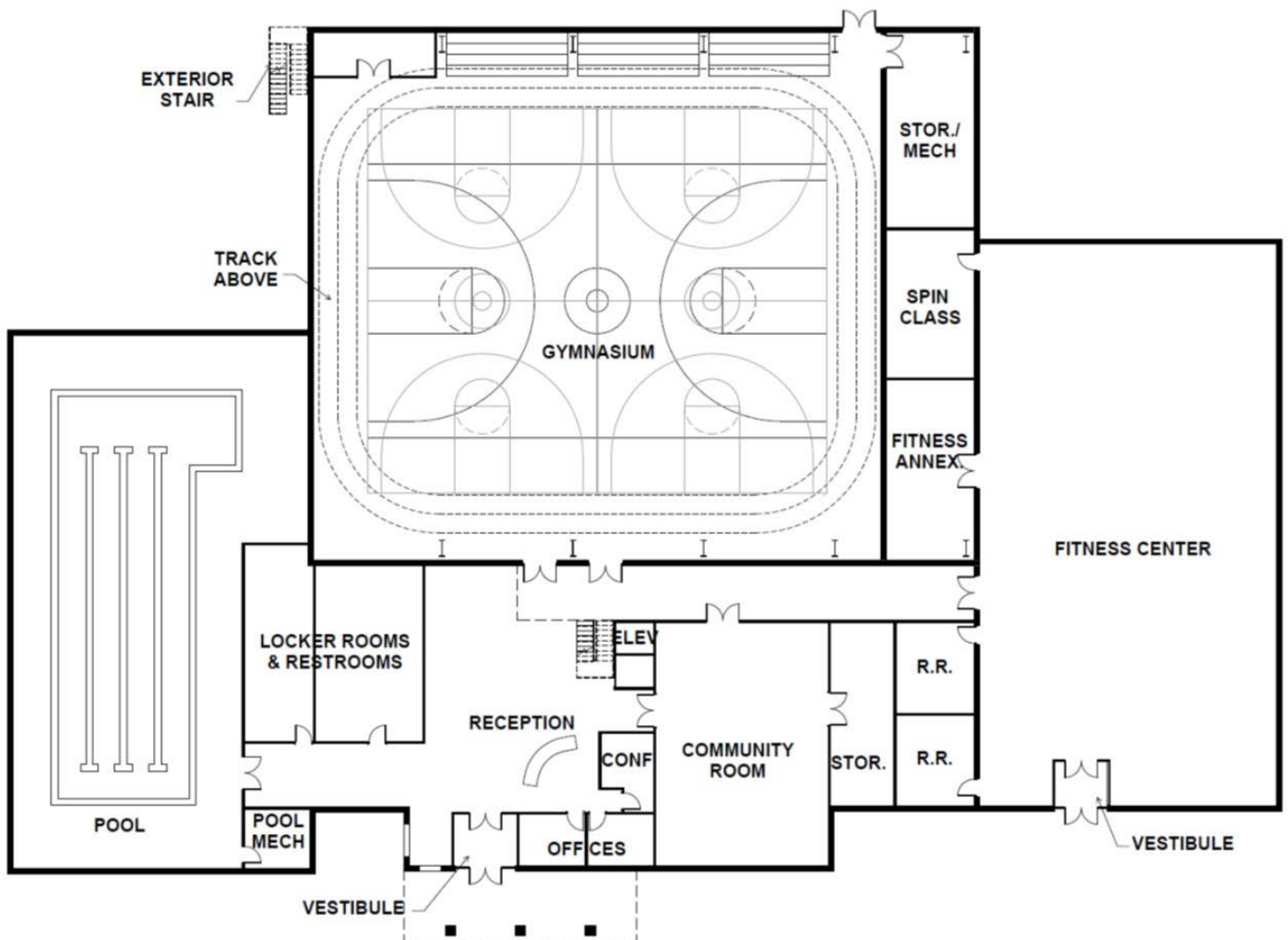

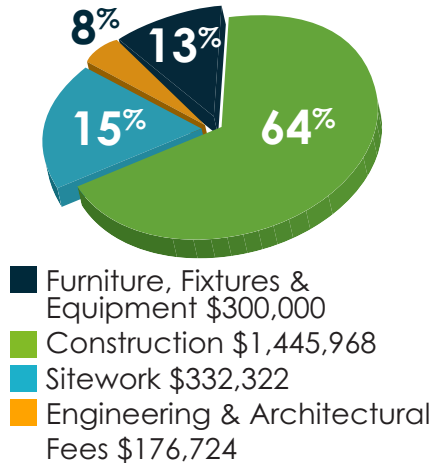


Projected Floor Plan

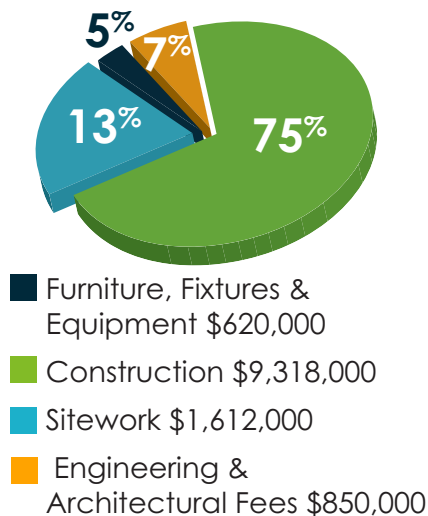
